WHEREAS, scleroderma is a chronic, progressive a utoimmune disease like meuma toid arthritis, lupus and multiple sclerosis whic h a ffec ts over 300,000 people in the United States; the disea se causes the body's immune system to attack its own tissues; and

WHEREAS, the disease, which literally means "hardskin," can cause thic kening and tightening of the skin as well as serious damage to a number of organs including the lungs, heart, kidneys, esophagus, a nd ga strointestinal tract; and

WHEREAS, scleroderma occurs three to four times more often in women than in men. Of all the a utoimmune disea ses affecting over 50 million Americ ans, sclerodema is the most fatal and least recognized disea se. There is no known cause or cure; and

WHEREAS, the Sclerodema Foundation helpspeople with the disea se and their fa milies cope through support programs, physician referrals and more. The Foundation promotes public awareness about sclerodema and is the largest private funder of peer-reviewed research awarding more than $\$ 1$ million annually; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, November 1, 2014, the Scleroderma Foundation of Southeast Florida will host the 11th a nnual "Stepping Out to Cure Sc lerodema Walk" at Tra dewinds Park in Coconut Creek in an effort to raise much needed funds for research to improve treatment and discover the cause and cure of scleroderma.
