Recommendation

At the request of the applicant Crown Castle NG East LLC and City Staff, it is recommended that the City Commission reschedule the *De Novo* Hearing to review applications for the installation of above-grade communications facilities at eight locations in the city right-of-way.

Background

On November 4, 2014 the City Commission voted to set the *De Novo* hearing for December 17, 2014. City Staff and representatives of the applicant since met and revisions to the submittal are forthcoming. These revisions to the applications are proposed by the applicant to minimize the impact to surrounding areas, provide improvements to public safety such as street lighting and improve the aesthetic appeal to the streetscape and neighborhood with additional landscaping and street trees.

A reschedule of the *De* Novo hearing is requested by the applicant due to ongoing discussions between the applicant and the City in order to resolve outstanding issues related to the denials.
