TITLE:	George T. Lohmeyer Wastewater Treatment Plant (GTL) Grit Chamber Rehabilitation - \$1,267,957.93				

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the award of the grit chamber rehabilitation at GTL to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder David Mancini & Sons, Inc.(Mancini) in the amount of \$1,267,957.93.

Background

The grit chamber rehabilitation project includes removal and replacement of the protective concrete coatings, deteriorated concrete and reinforcing steel in the walls, slabs, beams, and columns of two grit chambers located in the pretreatment building. Repair to the steel associated with mechanical grit removal equipment, replacement of the drive units and replacement of pipe supports, electrical conduit and wire and steel bridges are also required.

Invitation to Bid 953-11434 (P11876) was opened on November 7, 2014 and three responses were received. David Mancini & Sons, Inc. is the lowest cost responsive and responsible bidder. Staff is requesting approval to award the contract to David Mancini & Sons, Inc.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$1,267,957.93 for the contract and \$117,900.07 for estimated engineering fees, for a total of \$1,385,858.
