Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase and installation of a new shade structure for Riverland Park from PlayCore Wisconsin, Inc. in the amount of \$62,736 *via U.S.* Communities Contract 110179.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval to purchase a new shade structure for Riverland Park to provide enhancement to the playground for neighbors and visitors.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(7), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, this purchase will be made from Playcore Wisconsin, Inc. in the amount of \$62,736 *via* U.S. Communities Contract 110179 between Mecklenburg County, North Carolina and Playcore Wisconsin, Inc. dba GameTime.
