TITLE: Task Order to Keith and Schnars P.A., for engineering services related to

replacement of a 10-inch gravity sewer main - \$43,100

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 1 with Keith and Schnars P.A. in an amount not to exceed \$43,100 to design the replacement of a 10-inch Sanitary Sewer Main crossing the Tarpon River along South Andrews Avenue.

Background

The Tarpon River 10-inch gravity sewer main at Andrews Avenue was originally attached to the culvert bridge located at the intersection of Andrews Avenue and Rose Drive (Exhibit 2). Over time, the straps which affix the pipe to the culvert have corroded and broken, causing the pipe to sag significantly (Exhibit 3). There is now potential for failure of the pipe. Additionally, the pipe is also limiting access to the waterway under the bridge for kayaking and canoeing.

Staff is concerned that if the pipe breaks, it would discharge raw sewage into the Tarpon River, endangering public health and creating an environmental hazard. City crews provided an interim solution by installing temporary supports to keep the pipe from further sagging into the river. Staff proposes to redesign and replace the 10-inch sewer main and supports expeditiously to address potential environmental impacts and improve waterway access.

This Task Order is issued in accordance with the City's continuing contract for engineering consultant services, (Contract No. 626-10881-5) approved by the Commission on October 21, 2014.

This task order encompasses a scope of services including survey, design plans, standard details, permits, construction documents, construction cost estimating, bidding assistance, and construction services.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$43,100 for the task order and \$4,310 for estimated engineering fees, for a total of \$47,410.
