**TITLE:** Reject All Proposals for Smart Parking and Data Applications

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission reject all proposals for the purchase of Smart Parking and Data Applications, and find that the public interest will be served thereby.

**Background**

When the Smart Parking and Data Application Request for Proposal (RFP) 544-11359 was issued on February 3, 2014, the intention was to award a standard four year contract. After the RFP committee met on April 10, 2014, a decision was made to make this a contract with automatic annual renewals. In order to fairly assess all potential vendors, and allow a solicitation using the new criteria, staff recommends that the City Commission reject all bids pursuant to Subsection 2-180(5), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
