**TITLE:** REVISED CM -12 - Motion to approve Fourth Addendum to Revocable  
License with B-cycle, LLC

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a Fourth Amendment to the B-cycle Revocable License Agreement granted to B-cycle, LLC to add three stations, and authorize execution thereof.

**Background**

On July 6, 2011, the City Commission approved a Revocable License with B-cycle, LLC, to allow bike-sharing stations on city-owned property.

On October 28, 2015, the Development Review Committee reviewed B-cycle LLC's application for the addition of two stations and found it in compliance with the criteria regarding location of bicycle sharing stations as provided in the Code of Ordinances.

In accordance with the proposed Fourth Amendment to Permit and License Agreement (Exhibit 1), B-cycle LLC is requesting to add stations at (i) the Northwest corner E. Las Olas Blvd. & SE 10<sup>th</sup> Terrace, (ii) the Fort Lauderdale Beach Parking Lot (south end) and (iii) E. Sunrise Boulevard, South side, approximately 750 feet ~~South~~ East of Bayview Drive. Site plans and location maps for the station expansion are attached as part of Exhibit 1. Note as to (iii) above, that site is located in an FDOT right-of-way and therefore does not require issuance of City of Fort Lauderdale Engineering Permits.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

**Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.

- Objective 2: Integrate transportation land use and planning to create a walkable and bikeable community.
- Initiative 4: Develop bike amenities.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale Vision Plan 2035: We Are Connected*.
