Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager's service as a member of the National Civic League (NCL) Board of Directors.

Background

Section 4.05 of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale requires that service by the City Manager on any committee, board, or of an officer of any enterprise, compensated or not, while in the City's service, be approved by the City Commission by resolution.

The City Manager has been requested to serve on the Board of Directors of the National Civic League for a three-year term that may be renewed twice.

The NCL's mission is to strengthen democracy by increasing the capacity of the nation's people to effectively and responsibly participate in and build healthy, prosperous communities across America. NCL accomplishes its mission is by fostering and sharing promising practices of local government and public engagement and by celebrating the progress that can be achieved when people work together.
