TITLE: Application for a Dock Permit for usage of public property by Jack Hayes Properties, LLC at 1009 Cordova Road

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property for Jack Hayes Properties, LLC, located at 1009 Cordova Road, Fort Lauderdale, FL.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances, for the use, maintenance and repair of an existing 40 foot long x 5 foot wide marginal dock and landscaping improvements in the City Right of Way (ROW) adjacent to 1009 Cordova Road. A copy of the submitted landscaping plan is attached as Exhibit 5. Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by private persons of public property by private persons, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application (12 to 0) (Exhibit 3).

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.
