TITLE: Southwest 9th Street Sanitary Sewer Extension Design Services– Keith

and Schnars - \$53,715

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 2 (Exhibit 1) with Keith and Schnars, P.A. in the amount of \$53,715 for a sanitary sewer extension design services on Southwest 9th Street.

Background

The neighbors on the private road extension of Southwest 9th Street requested sanitary sewers to serve the properties west of Riverside Drive to Interstate 95 (Exhibit 2). Currently the properties are either undeveloped or on septic tank services. The lack of utility easements from the parcels' owners prevented the installation of sanitary sewers in the private road during the Water Works 2011 (Project Number 10578A, Riverside Park Basin A). The owners have dedicated the required utility easements to the City to allow for the construction and maintenance of public utilities in 2014. To improve fire protection and potable water service to the properties, a water main extension was included in the scope. This project was funded in the approved Fiscal Year 2015 Community Investment Plan.

This task order is being entered into pursuant to the Continuing Contract for Civil Engineering Consultant Services Agreement (Contract 626-10881) with Keith and Schnars, P.A., in accordance with the terms of the agreement for professional services dated November 6, 2012 and renewed on October 21, 2014. This task order is being performed under the terms and conditions of the Amended Master Agreement.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$53,715 for the task order and \$5,371 for estimated engineering fees, for a total of \$59,086.
