| TITLE: | Grant application to the Florida Inland Navigation District, Waterway Assistance Program for a Waterway Cleaning Vessel |

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the City Manager's submission of a grant application to the Florida Inland Navigation District for a grant to be used toward the acquisition of a Waterway Cleaning Vessel.

## **Background**

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) administers the Waterway Assistance Program (WAP) program. FIND provides funding assistance to local governments to perform waterway improvement projects. Marine law enforcement and other vessels are eligible for a maximum of \$30,000 in funding. The waterway cleaning vessel may be eligible for FIND funding in the "Other Waterway Related Projects" category. If awarded, grant funds will be used toward the acquisition of a waterway cleaning vessel (Exhibit 2).

## Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive impact to the City in the amount of \$20,000 which would allow for project implementation. There is no current year budget impact. Matching funds in the amount of \$20,000 have been identified in the Sanitation Fund FD409.

District funding is made available after October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Applicants must provide a minimum of 50% of the total project costs. The vessel, including the boat, skimmer and trailer, is estimated at \$40,000. Grant funds will be matched with a \$20,000 local match. Grant match will be appropriated in FY16. The application deadline is April 1, 2015.

## **Strategic Connections:**
