TITLE: First Reading of an Ordinance amendment to Ordinance C-13-39

vacating 15-foot wide alley associated with expansion of New Mount Olive

Baptist Church

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt on first reading an ordinance amending Ordinance C-13-39 which vacated a portion of right-of-way for the New Mount Olive Baptist Church expansion, but which Ordinance No. C-13-39 has not yet gone into effect.

Background

On October 1, 2013, the City Commission adopted an ordinance vacating a 15-foot wide, 9,000 square-foot portion of right-of-way to construct a new parking lot for the New Mount Olive Baptist Church expansion. Ordinance C-13-39 was structured in a manner that did not permit the vacation to go into effect until the completion of the development. However, pursuant to ULDR Section 47-24.5.A.2, Platting, construction of the development cannot commence until recordation of the plat is completed.

The proposed amendment to Ordinance C-13-39 will eliminate "completion of the development" as a condition of the Ordinance going into effect. With the adoption of this amendment, all other conditions have been met, allowing the Engineer's Certificate to be executed and recorded, thereby putting into effect the vacation of the alley and allowing the developer to move forward with construction of the project.

Ordinance C-13-39 is attached as Exhibit 1. The draft amended ordinance is attached as Exhibit 2.
