RESOLUTION NO. 15-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FINAL OPERATING BUDGET OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #15-0010 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-154, adopted on September 10, 2014, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2014, and ending September 30, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2014, and ending September 30, 2015, is hereby amended by appropriating funds as set forth in Commission Agenda Memo #15-0010, copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.

Consolidated Budget Amendment

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget.

Background

Budget amendments are consolidated into one agenda item for consideration at the first meeting of each month.

Examples of recommended actions within the consolidated budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget and Community Investment Plan by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

City Manager

A. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative (CHHC) Grant - \$519,831

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded a renewal grant in the amount of \$446,929 from the Florida Housing and Urban Department (HUD) for the Fort Lauderdale Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative (CHHC) Project. This project provides permanent supportive housing to the most vulnerable chronically homeless. Funding will be used to provide housing units, supportive services, program operations, and administrative costs. Additional cash matches will be provided by the United Way (\$30,000) and the City's General Fund (\$42,902). The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 15-0084).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$519,831 for the Fort Lauderdale Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative (CHHC) Project.

Fire-Rescue

B. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Grant - \$5,476

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded a grant in the amount of \$5,476 from the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management for the Community Emergency response Team (CERT). The CERT program promotes partnership between local emergency service providers and the citizens they serve, by training citizens in basic emergency preparedness, response and recovery skills and other preparation necessary to function as auxiliary personnel to first responders. There is no match requirement. Funds will be used to offset instructor costs and purchase of training materials. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 15-0123).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$5,476 for the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) grant.

C. Acceptance of grant funding and appropriation— Grants Fund — Citizen Corps Grant Program - \$5,466

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded a grant in the amount of \$5,466 from the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management for the Citizen Corps Grant Program. The Citizens Corps program promotes partnership between local emergency service providers and the citizens they serve, by training citizens in basic emergency preparedness, response and recovery skills. There is no match requirement. Funds will be used to offset instructor costs and purchase of training materials. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 15-0124).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$5,466 for the Citizen Corps Grant Program.

Parks and Recreation

D. Acceptance and appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund and General Fund – Florida Highway Beautification Council Grant - \$239,096

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded grant funding in the amount of \$100,000 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the median maintenance from North Atlantic Boulevard to Oakland Park Boulevard. Funding will be used to improve overall aesthetics of the City's medians by removing lifeless plants, installation of new plants and irrigation system. There is a cash match requirement of \$139,096, which is identified in the General Fund. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 14-1512).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund and General Fund in the amount of \$239,096 for the Florida Highway Beautification Grant.

E. Acceptance of grant funding and appropriation – Grants Fund – wheelchair tennis grant - \$4,500

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded a grant in the amount of \$4,500 from the United States Tennis Association (USTA) Florida Foundation to promote the growth of wheelchair tennis and to provide better health and fitness opportunities to physically challenged individuals. Funds will be used to offset costs of coaching staff, special events, and equipment. There is no match requirement.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$4,500 for the City's wheelchair tennis program.

Transportation and Mobility

F. Acceptance of grant funding and appropriation – Grants Fund – Streetscape Improvements in the Downtown Mobility Hub - \$3.5 million

The City of Fort Lauderdale is a sub-recipient of a grant in the amount of \$3.5 million from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) to provide design and construction of streetscape improvements in the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Mobility Hub. Streetscape improvements will enhance pedestrian and bicycle connectivity with the mass transit services and facilitate ease of movement throughout the four-block project area. There is no match requirement. The sub-recipient grant agreement is a companion item on this agenda (14-1357).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$3.5 million for the Streetscape Improvements in the Downtown Mobility Hub.

G. Appropriation from fund balance – General Capital Projects Fund – Marshall's Point Bridge Noise Mitigation Project - \$152,000

The Marshall's Point Bridge Noise Mitigation Project is completed; however, the project account was closed prior to payment of the final invoices and all the remaining funds at that time were transferred to the fund balance. In order to make the final payments from the project account, staff recommends the restoration of the project transfer funds in the amount of \$152,000 from fund balance.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$152,000 to finalize the Marshall's Point Bridge Noise Mitigation Project.
