**TITLE:** Golden Heights Curbing Project – Sagaris Corp. - \$55,755

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the award of the Golden Heights curbing project to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Sagaris Corp. (Sagaris), in the amount of \$55,755.

**Background**

The Golden Heights curbing project includes the removal of asphalt pavement, followed by the construction of concrete curbing and swales, and is meant to enhance the appearance of the Golden Heights Neighborhood.

Invitation to Bid 253-11492 was opened on January 16, 2015, and four responses were received.

**Resource Impact**

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$55,755. The available balance in the chart below reflects the amount remaining after the removal of pre-encumbrances established for this purchase.
