TITLE: City Hall ADA Improvements - Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC – \$44,250

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 2 with Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC for City Hall improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) in the amount of \$44,250.

Background

On September 24, 2013, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) notified the City of ADA noncompliance issues in City Hall. The City currently has a voluntary compliance agreement in place with HUD. This project will address accessibility from the parking lot into City Hall, ADA accessibility within City Hall 1st and 8th floor bathrooms, and accessibility to and within Commission Chambers.

Staff has negotiated Task Order No. 2 and the associated fees with Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC to provide design services in an amount not to exceed \$44,250. The task order will consist of providing schematic design, preparing construction plans and bid specifications, as well as assistance during the bidding process and contract administration.

This task order is being entered into pursuant to the General Architectural Consulting Services Agreement with Synalovski Romanik Saye LLC, dated August 19, 2014 between the City and the consultant.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$44,250 for the task order and \$4,425 for estimated engineering fees for a total of \$48,675.
