## **RESOLUTION NO. 15-37**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO TRANSMIT THE CORDOVA ROAD APPLICATION AS THE CITY'S PRIORITY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM ("TAP") GRANT THROUGH THE BROWARD COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION.

WHEREAS, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is providing funds to local governments for nontraditional related projects, such as traffic calming and bike facilities, through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, the MPO will receive TAP funds from FDOT and will be disbursing it to local governments based on applications(s) submitted; and

WHEREAS, the projects will aid in the realization the "We Are Connected" goal of the <u>Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale Vision</u> by improving transportation options including bike lanes and improved pedestrian accommodations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects are in compliance with the City's Complete Streets Policy; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects implement the Connecting the Blocks Program by increasing connectivity for multiple modes of transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida does hereby authorize the proper city officials to submit the Cordova Road Mobility Project as the City's priority project to the Florida Department of Transportation for funding of \$983,032 for its FY2017/2018 Transportation Alternatives Program Grant.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That the City Commission hereby authorizes staff to move forward for funding for the Cordova Road for the FY2017/2018 Transportation Alternatives Program Grant.
