PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

This Task Order is being entered into pursuant to the Continuing Contract for Civil Engineering Consultant Services Agreement (Contract 626-10881) between the City of Fort Lauderdale (CITY) and KEITH and SCHNARS, P.A. (CONSULTANT) in accordance with the terms of the agreement for professional services dated November 6, 2012 and renewed on October 21, 2014, between CITY and CONSULTANT ("MASTER AGREEMENT").

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The project involves extending an existing gravity sanitary sewer system to provide service to three single family home parcels and one vacant parcel with the potential for larger-scale development. In addition, CITY would like to extend a watermain approximately 300' west of Riverside Drive to accommodate service. The parcels are located south of SW 9th Street, east of I-95, named in the attached Exhibit "B" as Aziz, Feydt, Chiverton, and Ferrera. Due to a lack of right-of-way, utility easements will be acquired from each owner of the abutting parcels on SW 9th Street. Parcel Owners shall provide the CITY with properly executed Utility Easement Deeds. CITY has responsibility for coordination of the easements.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

CONSULTANT to provide services for customer outreach, survey, utility locates, design, permitting, bid assistance, periodic construction inspection, and certification of proposed water and sanitary sewer mains. The intent is to tie into the proposed sanitary system at an existing manhole located at the intersection of SW 9th Street and Riverside Drive. The assumption is that the existing manhole has sufficient depth to accommodate a gravity system accounting for minimum slope, cover, and private-side connections. All assumptions will be verified through the design process. Parameters for potential development of Ferrera parcel shall be coordinated with owner through CITY.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND DELIVERABLES

With approval of this Task Order, CONSULTANT shall provide professional services described in the tasks below:

Task No. 22001 Survey Base File:

CONSULTANT shall perform a Topographic Survey for engineering design purposes of a portion of SW 9th Street. The limits are from 25 feet east of the intersection of SW 9th Street and Riverside Drive, extending westerly along SW 9th Street approximately 500 feet to the East Right of Way of I-95. The limits also extend southerly from the North Right of Way line of SW 9th Street approximately 60 feet.

Services include establishing a baseline at 50 foot stations. Cross sections will be obtained at 25 foot intervals along the entire project including high and low points. Asbuilt information of gravity utility lines and clean outs will be obtained. 
