

RECOMMENDATION E-1 AMENDED

RECOMMENDATION DESCRIPTION:

Phase in a portion of the North Side Elementary School boundary so that all kindergarten students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2015-2016, kindergarten and first grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2016-2017, kindergarten through second grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2017-2018, kindergarten through third grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2018-2019, kindergarten through third grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2018-2019, kindergarten through fourth grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2018-2019, kindergarten through fourth grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2019-2020, and kindergarten through fifth grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2020-2021. Students in grades not specifically included in the phase-ins may be admitted if space is available.




AMENDMENT:

AREAS AFFECTED:



RECOMMENDATION E-2 AMENDED

RECOMMENDATION DESCRIPTION:

Phase in a portion of the Walker Elementary School boundary so that all kindergarten students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2015-2016, kindergarten and first grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2016-2017, kindergarten through second grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2017-2018, kindergarten through third grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2018-2019, kindergarten through third grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2018-2019, kindergarten through fourth grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2019-2020, and kindergarten through fifth grade students in the designated area will be assigned to Harbordale Elementary School in 2020-2021. Students in grades not specifically included in the phase-in may be admitted if space is available.

AREAS AFFECTED:

Commence at the intersection of East Sunrise Boulevard and the Middle River, south along the Middle River to Sunrise Key Boulevard extended, west along Sunrise Key Boulevard extended to Northeast 6th Court, west along Northeast 6th Court to North Victoria Park Road, south along North Victoria Park Road to South Victoria Park Road extended, south along South Victoria Park Road extended to Southeast 2nd Court, west along Southeast 2nd Court to Southeast 17th Avenue, south along Southeast 17th Avenue to East Las Olas Boulevard, east along East Las Olas Boulevard to the canal west of Mola Avenue, south along the canal west of Mola Avenue to the New River, west along the New River to Federal Highway, north along Federal Highway to Northeast 6th Street, east along Northeast 6th Street to Northeast 15th Avenue, north along Northeast 15th Avenue to East Sunrise Boulevard, and east along East Sunrise Boulevard to the Middle River.
