TITLE:	Increase expenditure for plumbing maintenance services - contract 543-11377 - \$50,000

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in expenditure for plumbing maintenance services provided by A-1 Paradise Plumbing, Inc. d/b/a Paradise Service Technologies in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the contract period ending June 1, 2015.

#### **Background**

The City of Fort Lauderdale Parks and Recreation Department coordinates plumbing repairs and plumbing installations through the contracted vendor A-1 Paradise Plumbing. Staff originally estimated to spend approximately \$89,000 during the current contract period but due to many unforeseen repairs, installations and after hour emergencies an additional amount not to exceed \$50,000 will be needed for these repairs during the current contract period ending June 1, 2015. The City is currently in the process of hiring an additional plumber via job recruitment through the Human Resources Department and anticipate the contract usage to decrease significantly with the hiring of a full time plumber.

## Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$50,000.
