TITLE: Settlement of Workers' Compensation Claim of Bonnie Handsborough in

the amount of \$55,750.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a motion approving the settlement of the workers' compensation claim of Bonnie Handsborough in the amount of \$55,750.

Background

The claimant, Bonnie Handsborough, sustained injuries while in the course and scope of employment with the City, which have been accepted as compensable.

Through negotiations a settlement was reached in the amount of \$55,750. This amount is broken down as follows: (1) the claimant will net \$47,750 plus \$100 for a general release; and (2) the claimant's attorney will receive \$7,675 for fees and \$225 for costs. This settlement includes all future indemnity and medical benefits.
