Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution appointing the law firm of Corbett, White, Davis and Ashton, P.A., as special counsel in connection with the completion of the City of Fort Lauderdale's Right-of-Way Distributed Antenna System Ordinance.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale is currently using Miami Beach's ordinance as a model for its own ordinance, yet the City desires to complete its own Right-of-Way Distributed Antenna System Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office recommends appointing Corbett, White, Davis and Ashton, P.A., as special counsel and to establish the fees for special counsel.

Further, special counsel proposes an hourly rate of \$225.00 per hour to complete all tasks associated with this project including meeting with City Staff, drafting code, attending follow-up meetings with both City Staff and telecommunications industry stakeholders at the City's direction, and attendance at all required public hearings for ordinance adoption.
