TITLE: Emergency Equipment for Law Enforcement Vehicles – Strobes-R-Us,

Inc. - \$180,000 (one year cost)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an agreement for the purchase of emergency equipment for law enforcement vehicles *via* the Broward County Sheriff's Office (BSO) Contract 13104030 from Strobes-R-Us, Inc., in substantially the form attached, in the estimated annual amount of \$180,000 and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year options, contingent upon appropriation of the funds and the renewal of the contract by BSO and Strobes-R-Us, Inc.

Background

First responder vehicles, as well as other City vehicles operating in the right-of-ways, require emergency equipment and warning lights to operate safely and meet Florida Department of Transportation and public safety requirements. The BSO contract provides a cost effective and efficient procurement vehicle for the City that takes advantage of economies of scale due to BSO's large purchasing volume.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(7) Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the City may buy from another governmental entity's contract whereby such contract followed formal bid procedures of sealed written bids, public opening, and legal advertising. Contract 1310403 complies with Section 2-181(7). This contract was awarded by BSO for a two (2) year term commencing on August 12, 2013 and ending on August 11, 2015 with two (2) additional one (1) year renewal terms.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$180,000.
