TITLE: Resolution Dedicating Portions of City-Owned Properties as Public Right-

of-Way for Purposes of the Complete Streets Program

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution (Exhibit 1) to dedicate portions of City-owned property as public right-of-way for purposes of the Complete Streets Program.

Background

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is currently designing a complete street on Northwest 9th Avenue from Sistrunk Boulevard to Broward Boulevard, as a Local Agency Program (LAP) Project. As part of this project, FDOT is redesigning a portion of the roadway and sidewalk on Northwest 9th Avenue which currently extends onto City-owned properties.

Pursuant to FDOT requirements, in order to reconstruct or improve the roadway and sidewalks, re-dedication of this right-of-way will be required. The properties are Lot 17 and Lot 18 Block B, respectively, at the southeast corner of Northwest 9th Avenue and Northwest 4th Street. A detailed description and sketch of each property is provided in Exhibit 2. Additional property affected by this program is being addressed separately under CAM #15-0401. The improved and re-platted properties will continue to be Cityowned.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.

This is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.
