FLORIDA, FOR **FISCAL** THE YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NUMBER 1 AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #15-0422 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 is for scope revisions and adjustment of the guaranteed maximum price (GMP) to the Aquatic Complex Developer's Agreement with Recreational Design and Construction, Inc. (RDC) in the amount of \$1,238,068;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. <u>SECTION 3</u>. That the Change Order No. 1 is approved for scope revisions and adjustment of the guaranteed maximum price (GMP) to the Aquatic Complex Developer's Agreement with Recreational Design and Construction, Inc. (RDC) in the amount of \$1,238,068.
