TITLE: Motion Authorizing Professional Services for Sanitary Sewer and Water Main Improvements Project at Southwest 8th Street - Keith and Schnars, P.A. -\$32,010

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 9 (Exhibit 1) with Keith and Schnars, P.A. for small water main improvements design services in Victoria Park (Exhibit 2) in the amount of \$32,010.

Background

This project involves the installation of 340 linear feet of gravity sewer and the replacement of 330 linear feet of existing undersized water mains on Southwest 8th Street. This project was originally designed by City staff to address sanitary service along Southwest 8th Street only, but at this time staff recommends the upgrade of existing water mains. No submittals have been made to permitting agencies and the current design plans require revisions to include water mains.

This task order is being entered into pursuant to the continuing contract for civil engineering consultant services (Contract 626-10881) with Keith and Schnars, P.A., in accordance with the terms of the amended master agreement dated November 6, 2012 (CAR #12-2299) and renewed on October 21, 2014 (CAM #14-1066). .

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$32,010 for the task order and \$3,201 for in house project management fees, for a total of \$35,211.
