TITLE: YMCA at Holiday Park

Parks and Recreation staff has been approached by the Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA) with the possibility of developing a YMCA site at Holiday Park. The potential location for the facility is a City-owned vacant parcel on North Federal Highway directly west of Parker Playhouse.

Attached are several slides depicting what a future YMCA site may look like (Exhibit 1). Also, attached as Exhibit 2, is a term sheet relating to the potential development. One item that remains outstanding is how to handle the current programs in the activity center located directly south of the proposed new YMCA. Both the YMCA and the City of Fort Lauderdale's Parks and Recreation Department believe it would be advantageous to move the current Gymnastics, Aikido, and Yoga programs to the new YMCA facility if funding for the additional square footage is available.

Staff is looking for direction on the proposed agreement and partnership with the YMCA.
