TITLE: Motion to Approve Amended Lease Agreement for 1600 NE 12th Terrace

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the execution of an Amended Lease Agreement for property at 1600 NE 12th Terrace with continued use by the Fort Lauderdale Police Department for office area as well as confiscation and evidence storage.

Background

The City will pay \$120,162.80 per year, payable in equal monthly installments of \$10,013.56. The base rent shall escalate on an annual basis at the rate of (3) percent or the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI), whichever is lower.

The lease term will be for a five (5) year period, commencing on September 1, 2015. The City shall have the option to renew this lease for three (3) successive five (5) year periods.

As part of the lease agreement, the landlord has agreed to make structural, HVAC, and electrical improvements estimated at \$154,495.00.

Resource Impact

The cost impact for this fiscal year will be for one month's rent at \$10,013.56. Subsequent lease expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
