TITLE: Resolution Ratifying a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the

Federation of Public Employees, a Division of NFPPE, AFL-CIO, effective

August 18, 2015 through September 30, 2016

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution ratifying a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Federation of Public Employees, a Division of NFPPE, AFL-CIO (Federation), effective August 18, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

### **Background**

The previous Federation Collective Bargaining Agreement expired on September 30, 2013. The City and Federation began negotiations for a successor agreement in January 2014 and met fourteen times. Through these negotiations, the City and Federation came to a tentative agreement. The tentative agreement will be presented to the Federation membership for a ratification vote on August 14, 2015. We anticipate the bargaining unit members will vote in favor of ratification.

An outline of the significant changes to the collective bargaining agreement is included in Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

#### **Resource Impact**

There will be a Fiscal Year 2015 impact of approximately \$73,000 to the City, funding for which is available within the affected departmental operating budgets. It is projected that funding impact will be \$346,000 for Fiscal Year 2016. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.
