TITLE: Beach Place Security Plan Status

Background

At the January 21, 2015 City Commission Meeting, the City Commission on a 4-1 vote (Commissioner Trantalis opposed) approved the Security Plan for Beach Place.

The elements of the approved Security Plan were:

1. 300 hours per week of private security.
2. Two off-duty police officers on Fridays from 4 pm to closing (from September 1st through March 31st).
3. Two off-duty police officers on Saturdays from 12 pm to closing (from September 1st through March 31st).
4. Two off-duty police officers on Sundays (from September 1st through March 31st) from 12 pm until 4 pm.
5. Two off-duty police officers during hours when alcohol is sold during Spring Break (February 20th through March 31st); New Year's Eve, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.
6. Signage posted at all areas of egress at the property advising people that open containers of alcohol are prohibited from leaving the property.
7. Crowd control barriers at entranceways when there are larger than normal crowds.
8. Replacement of live-feed camera with CCTV cameras that have the ability to record.
9. Additional two CCTV cameras on first and second levels leading from the plaza to the garage and loading dock double doors.
10. Weekly reports submitted to the City Manager.
11. The bi-directional antenna system (BOA) serving the property to allow the Fort Lauderdale public safety radios to operate inside the property must be repaired and be fully operational no later than February 28, 2015.
