Justice Grant Funds - \$27,777

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$27,777 from the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice (FDJJ), and pursuant to City of Fort Lauderdale Resolution NO. 14-62, authorize the City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Mount Bethel Human Services (MBHS) as approved by the FDJJ.

## **Background**

In January 2015, the City submitted an application to the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to deliver services that address the issue of overrepresentation of minority youth in Florida's juvenile justice system. This program will partner with MBHS to address Disproportionate Minority Contact (DMC) through the provision of DMC curriculum training, focus groups and DMC analysis reports. The grant period is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016.

# Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$27,777. The grant does not require matching funds. <u>Funding is contingent upon the approval of Consolidated Budget CAM 15-0955 scheduled for the September 1, 2015 Regular Commission Meeting.</u>
