

RESOLUTION NO. 15-164

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND FEDERATION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, A DIVISION OF THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EMPLOYEES, AFL-CIO, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING AUGUST 19, 2015, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the city manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale and the bargaining agent of Federation of Public Employees, a division of the National Federation of Public and Private Employees, AFL-CIO, have reached an agreement on a proposed collective bargaining agreement regarding the collective bargaining units defined in the Florida Public Employees Relations Commission's Verification of Election Results and Certification of Exclusive Collective Bargaining Representative, Certification Numbers 1521 and 1523, dated November 30, 2004, for the period beginning August 19, 2015, through September 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale employees who are members of the collective bargaining units defined in the Florida Public Employees Relations Commission's Verification of Election Results and Certification of Exclusive Collective Bargaining Representative, Certification Numbers 1521 and 1523, dated November 30, 2004, have ratified the proposed collective bargaining agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Federation of Public Employees, a division of the National Federation of Public and Private Employees, AFL-CIO, regarding the collective bargaining units defined in Florida Public Employees Relations Commission Certifications Numbers 1521 and 1523 dated November 30, 2004, for the period August 19, 2015, through September 30, 2016, is approved and ratified, and the City Commission authorizes execution of the collective bargaining agreement.
