TITLE:	Motion to Approve Animal Carcass Removal and Disposal Services - Jacksonville Animal Removal LLC- \$60,000 (three-year cost)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three-year contract with Jacksonville Animal Removal LLC for the purchase of animal carcass removal and disposal services, in substantially the form attached, in the estimated annual amount of \$20,000 (three-year estimated amount of \$60,000); and authorize the City Manager to approve a one-year renewal option contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting a contract for the purchase of animal carcass removal and disposal services throughout the City. Invitation to Bid number 853-11626 opened on July 7, 2015 with three bids received. The bid submitted by Jacksonville Animal Removal LLC has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be no current fiscal impact to the City. There will be a fiscal impact to the City for FY 16 in the estimated amount of \$20,000 contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Neighborhood Enhancement Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 5: Be a community of strong, beautiful, and healthy neighborhoods.
