- TITLE: Motion Authorizing Architectural Design Services for Renovations of the Transportation and Mobility Building – Walters Zackria Associates, PLLC – \$13,821.44 Task Order

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a task order (Exhibit 1) for architectural design services for the Transportation and Mobility (TAM) Building located at 290 NE 3rd Avenue Renovation with Walters Zackria Associates, PLLC, in the amount of \$13,821.

Background

This project will address space and functionality concerns regarding the TAM administration building. This project will reconfigure the first floor customer service area to add six additional workstations, relocating the accounting office to the first floor and adding three enclosed offices. It will include site documentation, schematic design layouts, and three dimensional renderings. The demolition and reconfiguration of the existing layout both the first and second floors and incorporates green technology where feasible.

Staff has negotiated a task order and the associated fees with Walters Zackria Associates, PLLC, to provide design services in an amount not to exceed \$13,821.

This task order is being entered into pursuant to the General Architectural Consulting Services Agreement with Walters Zackria Associates, PLLC, dated August 19, 2014 (CAM #14-0896, RFQ No. 936-11270 "MASTER AGREEMENT"). The scope of services for this task order includes, but is not limited to, schematic design, construction plan preparation, and permitting.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$13,821 for the task order.
