TITLE: Resolution to Approve the Consolidated Budget Amendment to Fiscal

Year 2016 - Appropriation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

Background

Budget amendments are consolidated into one agenda item for consideration at the first meeting of each month.

Examples of recommended actions within the consolidated budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- amendment to staffing level;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Operating Budget and Community Investment Plan by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

Finance

A. Appropriation from Fund Balance - Water and Sewer Fund - City Hall Drive Thru Kiosk - \$55,000

The Finance Department obtained proposals from vendors to provide an automated kiosk for the Drive-thru at City Hall. The kiosk is intended to automate the payment experience for our neighbors, who come to City Hall to pay their utility bill. Having this service will eliminate the need to have the drive thru staffed with personnel. The personnel currently in the building will be relocated inside to assist with telephone calls and walk in customers. It was expected to have this process completed and a vendor awarded in fiscal year 2015; however, the funds could not be carried forward and a budget amendment is required.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate Water and Sewer Fund accounts in the amount of \$55,000 to purchase an automated drive thru kiosk.

Police

B. Appropriation of Grant Funds - Grants Fund - FY 2015 Florida Department of Transportation Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety Program - \$13,719.42

The Police Department was awarded a Florida Department of Transportation grant in the amount of \$13,719.42 to reduce traffic crashes and fatalities involving pedestrians and bicyclists through the use of selected traffic education and enforcement operations. The grant will fund a public awareness and education campaign, as well as, a high visibility enforcement strategy over a 33 week period. No matching funds are required.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the Grants Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$13,719.42 for the Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety Grant.

C. Appropriation of Grant Funds and Transfer Between Projects - Grants Fund & General Capital Projects Fund - Police Boat and Fire Boat - \$1,165,749

The Police Department was awarded a Department of Homeland Security grant for the purchase of two Marine vessels to enhance public safety. The Police Department will be purchasing a 28 foot radiation detection equipped vessel and the Fire-Rescue Department will be purchasing a 40 foot fire rescue rapid response watercraft to provide increased emergency response and prevention capability which includes chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive (CBRNE) marine response activities; heavy firefighting suppression, emergency medical services, specialty team support; and detection, prevention, electronics, navigation, communications, command platform and other heavy support equipment. A 25% grant match of \$291,437 is required and available in the Police and Fire Boat Capital Project budgeted in FY 2016.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Grants Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$1,165,749 to purchase a Police Boat and a Fire-Rescue Boat.

D. Amend the Personnel Complement- General Fund – New Position Security Guard I - \$34,000

The personnel complement will be amended for the addition of one new Security Guard I position to allow for enhancement of City Hall security. The addition of one new Security Guard position to City Hall will bring the total count of Security Guards to 3.5 FTE's, as funds are budgeted in the Police Department from salary savings for this position.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the Personnel Compliment for FY 2016 for a new Security Guard I position offset by salary savings in the amount of \$34,000.

Public Works

E. Transfer between Capital Projects - Central Regional Wastewater System Fund - George T. Lohmeyer (GTL) Wastewater Treatment Plant Drainage System - \$233,451

This Wastewater Treatment Plant requires improvements to improve the drainage system for the GTL Wastewater Treatment plant. Numerous flooding complaints received from adjacent private property owners have resulted in the City's decision to pump the stormwater into the plant's treatment process during moderate to heavy rain events. This project will fund the design and construction of an adequate drainage system to address flooding issues due to extreme weather changes and lack of infrastructure.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Central Regional Wastewater System Fund in the amount of \$233,451 to facilitate the stormwater improvements at GTL Wastewater Treatment Plant.

F. Transfer between Capital Projects - Water and Sewer Fund - Relocation of Existing Water Main at E. Las Olas Blvd. - \$1,950,000

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) will be dredging approximately 14,300 linear feet of the Intra-Coastal Waterway (ICWW) main navigation channel in order to improve clearance for deep water vessels. The proposed dredging work conflicts with a City owned 16" water main at the E. Las Olas Blvd bridge crossing. This project will include the abandonment of the 16" water main and installing a new 20" water main. Failure to fund this priority project could result in the rupture of the existing 16" water main during the dredging of the proposed FIND project. Funds are available in the Fiveash Disinfection/Reliability Upgrades project to accomplish the necessary relocation of this water main.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Water and Sewer General Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$1,950,000 to facilitate the necessary relocation of the existing utilities at this location.

G. Transfer between Capital Projects – Water and Sewer Fund - Fiveash Water Treatment Plant Hydrotreators Modifications - \$550,000

The Hydrotreater connections and influent pipe in the Fiveash Water Treatment Plant need to be replaced at this time. Staff has determined that the steel fabrication and the connection are both corroded. Funds will be transferred from the Oakland Park Beach Area Water Main and the Central New River Water Main River Crossings, reprioritizing these two projects to a later date.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Water and Sewer General Capital Projects fund in the amount of \$550,000 to facilitate the repair of the influent pipe for the Hydrotreators. Replacing these components would extend the useful life of the Hyrdotreator concrete structures they serve by another 30 years.

H. Transfer between Capital Projects - Central Regional Wastewater System Fund - GTL Wastewater Treatment Plant Emergency Generator Connection & Electrical Switchgear Upgrades - \$1,600,000

The Wastewater Treatment Plant is in need of electrical upgrades to improve reliability by having two separate and independent sources of electrical power. This project will connect a portable generator to the electrical system and replace obsolete electrical equipment that has been identified for replacement. The final cost estimate indicates that additional funding in the amount of \$1,600,000 is necessary to complete this priority project. Funds are available in the George T. Lohmeyer (GTL) Motor Control Rehabilitation Project.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in Central Regional Waste Water System Fund in the amount of \$1,600,000 to complete the improvements to the electrical system and reliability of the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

I. Appropriation from Fund Balance - Water and Sewer General Capital Projects Fund - 30 Inch Water Main Replacement Broward Boulevard Bridge FDOT Replacement - \$250,000

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to replace the Broward Boulevard Bridge over the North Fork of the New River Canal, with construction expected to begin in June 2016. The City has a 30-inch transmission water main that runs alongside the bridge. This pipe requires removal to accommodate the bridge replacement. The Utility Work by Highway Contractor (UWHC) Agreement provides for the work completed by FDOT's contractor as part of the bridge project. The Three Party Escrow Agreement with FDOT and the Florida Division of Treasury provides for establishing an interest-bearing escrow account, into which the requisite funds would be deposited by the City, for the work performed on behalf of the City.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate Water and Sewer General Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$250,000 for the 30 Inch Water Main Replacement Broward Boulevard Bridge FDOT replacement.

Sustainable Development

J. Appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures - General Fund - Vacant Property and Foreclosure Services - \$60,000

The City of Fort Lauderdale is contracting with Community Champions Corporation for vacant property and foreclosure services, whereby the agreement provides a 50% return in revenue. In order to properly account for the recording of the revenue the entire amount should be realized and costs of the services expensed out. The FY 2016 budget only accounted for a portion of the revenue; to account for the entire amount, modifying the revenue and associated expenses is required.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Fund in the amount of \$60,000 for modified revenue and expenses for vacant property and foreclosure services.

Transportation and Mobility

K. Transfer between Capital Projects – Airport Fund – Executive Airport Master Plan Update - \$65,669

Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport staff proposes to update the current Master Plan in order to establish and communicate the City's mission, vision, organizational values, goals, and future action plans, to guide and optimize operation of Executive Airport. The new Master Plan would review the business environment influencing Airport activity; assure the environmentally sound, compatible, and financially feasible operation of the Airport; and provide guidance for its ongoing management and operation in a manner that balances the needs of the aviation and surrounding communities. The approximate time frame to complete the Master Plan is 12 months.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Airport Fund for \$65,669 to facilitate the Executive Airport Master Plan Update.

L. Appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures - General Fund & Grants Fund - Gas Tax contribution to the Transportation Management Association - \$226,724

Annually, the City provides a contribution to the Transportation Management Association (TMA) for the operation of the community bus link. A portion of the City's Gas Tax revenue is the budgeted for this purpose and requires moving to the Grants Fund for correct accounting.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Fund and the Grants Fund in the amount of \$226,724 for the City's General Fund contribution to the Transportation Management Association (TMA).
