**TITLE**: Motion to Approve Amendment to Agreement for Continuation of

Motorized Watercraft Concession - Atlantic Beach Clubs-Two, Inc. -

\$20,250 (Revenue)

## Recommendation

It is recommended the City Commission approve an amendment to the motorized watercraft concession services Contract 525-10962 with Atlantic Beach Clubs-Two, Inc. to provide for an additional three month extension with the same terms and conditions as provided in the original contract to allow time for a new Request for Proposal to be issued and awarded; and authorize the City Manager to execute such amendment.

## **Background**

On July 7, 2015 (CAM 15-0668), the City Commission rejected a single proposal and approved a 3-month extension to Atlantic Beach Clubs-Two, Inc. for motorized watercraft concession services thru October 31, 2015. To allow time for a new Request for Proposal to be issued and awarded, a three-month continuation is being requested.

## **Resource Impact**

There will be a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$20,250.
