ORDINANCE NO. C-15-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY AMENDING THE TITLES OF THREE CLASSES AND CREATING THREE CLASSES, AND AMENDING SECTION 20-83 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY DESIGNATING THREE CLASSES AS ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANTS TO THE CITY MANAGER, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Human Resources have recommended certain amendments to the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission agrees with the recommendation of the City Manager and Director of Human Resource to amend the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the following classes contained in Schedule I of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, are amended as follows:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That Schedule I of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended to create, and add in alphabetical order by class title, the following classes:

SECTION 3. That Section 20-83, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended to provide as follows:

The following professional managerial and administrative employees in the office of the city manager are administrative assistants to the city manager: administrative assistant, administrative assistant I, administrative assistant II, assistant to the city manager, senior assistant to the city manager, structural innovation manager, budget manager, public affairs manager, neighbor services manager, assistant budget manager, assistant manager of CIP (Community Investment Plan)/Grants, financial management analyst, senior financial management analyst, principal financial analyst, performance analyst, and senior performance analyst, chief service officer, and management analyst.

SECTION 4. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same SECTION 5. are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage.
