TITLE:	Motion to Approve CalAmp Tracking Devices for Automatic Vehicle Locator System – Fleet Analytics, LLC - \$156,600

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of CalAmp Tracking Devices from Fleet Analytics, LLC in the amount of \$156,600.

#### **Background**

On September 3, 2013 (CAM 13-1049), the City Commission approved the award of a five-year contract to provide a replacement automatic vehicle locator (AVL) system for marked patrol cars.

The AVL system currently in use by the Police Department helps improve productivity, officer safety, and the community's security. It provides a global view of where public safety vehicles are located and can provide a history of vehicle activity including location and speed. Staff is satisfied with the AVL system and now recommends purchasing 1,305 devices, expanding to the City's entire fleet of vehicles. The CalAmp tracking devices are a required component of the AVL system.

Invitation to Bid 552-11619 was opened on May 27, 2015 with two bids received. The bid submitted by Fleet Analytics, LLC has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

## Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$156,600.
