

RESOLUTION NO. 15-215

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE
URBAN LAND INSTITUTE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PANEL
REPORTS FOR THE UPTOWN URBAN VILLAGE, THE
RIVERWALK DISTRICT AND SISTRUNK BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale has partnered with the Urban Land Institute (ULI) to conduct studies of complex development issues in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City engaged ULI to host technical assistance panels (TAPs) to address the Uptown Urban Village, the Riverwalk District, and Sistrunk Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, ULI has developed Reports to address development topics for each of the studied districts; and



- SECTION 1. That hereby submits the following reports:
- (a) Developing Long-Term Strategies for Resiliency in the Face of Climate Change: The Uptown Urban Village
 - (b) Activation and Climate Adaptation in the Riverwalk District
 - (c) Creating a Socially and Economically Vibrant Sistrunk Boulevard Corridor
