**Executive Airport** 

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission accept grant funding in the amount of \$970,000 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for up to 80% of the cost for taxiway intersection improvements at fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) and approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) on behalf of the City.

## **Background**

This project is to provide for the design and construction costs to re-construct selected taxiway intersections (Exhibit 1) at the FXE to conform to the new Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) design standards.

There are seven taxiway intersections currently leading directly from the tenant aprons to the runways. The new design will eliminate these entrance points and minimize the possibility of an unauthorized runway incursion by aircrafts going directly from the apron to the runway. New taxiway edge lights, guidance signs, and pavement markings will be installed as part of this project.

With an estimated cost of \$1,212,500 to design and construct, FDOT has initiated a JPA in the amount of \$970,000 to provide up to 80% of the cost for taxiway intersection improvements. FXE's matching share of \$242,500 is provided for in FXE's adopted Community Investment Plan (CIP) for FY16.

# **Resource Impact**

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$970,000 for the grant contingent upon approval and appropriation of the November 3, 2015 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #15-1312. The required grant match of \$242,500 is available in the CIP.
