**TITLE:** Motion Accepting FY2016 Florida Department of Transportation Grant – \$13,719.42

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$13,719.42 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

**Background**

In June 2015, the City submitted an application to FDOT in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to deliver public awareness and enforcement campaigns related to pedestrian and bicyclist safety, which is a component of Florida's Bicycle/Pedestrian Focused Initiative Communication & High Visibility Enforcement Implementation under the direction of FDOT and the University of South Florida. The grant's enforcement activities are being implemented to remind and educate pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists of safe behaviors. The delivery of services must begin within 30 days of contract execution and must end on or before March 30, 2016.

**Resource Impact**

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$13,719.42. The grant does not require matching funds. Funding was approved on the consolidated budget amendment CAM 15-1165 at the October 6, 2015 regular agenda meeting.
