- TITLE: Resolution to Accept the 2015 Affordable Housing Advisory Committee's Incentive Report and Authorize Submittal to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution accepting the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program Affordable Housing Advisory Committee's (AHAC) Incentive Report and authorize the City Manager to execute all documents associated with the submittal of the report to Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC).

### **Background**

Section 420.9073(2) (b) 4, Florida Statutes requires all cities receiving SHIP funds to appoint an Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (*of no fewer than 11 members*) to triennially review its established policies, procedures, ordinances, land development regulations, and adopted local government comprehensive plan and make recommendations to encourage or facilitate affordable housing, while protecting the ability of the property to appreciate in value.

The AHAC is required to submit a report to the City that evalutes the implementation of the statutory affordable housing incentives strategies specified in 420.9076 (4) (a)-(k), Florida Statutes and any additional recommended affordable housing incentives.

The AHAC met on September 21, 2015 to complete the draft report. The final report (Exhibit 1) was affirmatively voted on at a public meeting held on October 7, 2015 (Exhibit 2).

The attached final report is being submitted to the City Commission for acceptance and approval for staff to submit it to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation by December 31, 2015.

### Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
