ROYAL UTILITY WATER TREATMENT PLANT HAS LEVELS OF TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES ABOVE DRINKING WATER STANDARDS

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation

We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Testing results from October 2014 to September 2015 show that our system exceeds the standard or maximum contaminant level (MCL), for Total Trihalomethanes (TTHMs) The standard or MCL for TTHMs is 80 parts per billion (ppb). It is determined by averaging all the samples collected at each sampling location for the past 12 months. The level of TTHMs averaged at one of our system's locations from Oc-tober 2014 to September 2015 was 83.9 ppb. Please note that the third quarter results for this particular location was 74.3 ppb (below the MCL).

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective actions. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 21 hours.
If you have a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at in-creased risk and should seek advice from our health care providers about drinking

What does this mean?

This is not an emergency. If it had been an emergency, you would have been notified within 24 hours. TTHMs are four volatile organic chemicals which form when disinfectants react with natural organic matter in the water.
*People who drink water containing tri-halomethanes in excess of the MCL over many years may experience problems with their liver, kidneys, or central nervous system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What is being done?

Four months ago Royal Utility changed disinfection method from chlorine to chloramines which is a combination of chlorine and ammonia in order to reduce the level of trihalomethanes in the water. The MCL exceedance reported in this notice is obtained by averaging the quarterly sample results from October 2014 to terry sample results from October 2015. Which reflect the MCL exceedances of previous quarters. The sample results of the second and third quarters of 2015 were below the maximum contaminant level (58.9ppb and 74.3ppb respectively).

Royal Utility Water Treatment Plant will continue to monitor and report the TTHMs results to you on a quarterly basis as long as any LRAA (locational running annual average) exceeds the MCL, as required.
