TITLE: Motion to Award a Contract for the Northwest 2nd Avenue Pump Station

Appearance Modifications Project to Sun Eagle General Contractors

Corporation in the amount of \$85,079

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract to Sun Eagle General Contractors Corporation (Sun Eagle), in substantially the form attached, for the NW 2nd Avenue pump station appearance modifications project, in the amount of \$85,079.

Background

The purpose of this project is to enhance the appearance of the exterior of the industrial-looking pump station on Northwest 2nd Avenue to blend in with the residential neighborhood.

The improvements will include adding a new tiled roof, repainting the exterior, construction of a new façade, installation of a stamped asphalt driveway, and installation of a decorative picket fence. The roofing portion of the bid included two options a) alternate one includes a roof with metal trusses; and b) alternate two includes a roof with wood trusses. Sun Eagle submitted the lowest bid for the base bid, as well as, for both alternates.

Invitation to Bid 253-11654 was opened on September 24, 2015, and three bids were received. Staff is recommending to award the contract including alternate one for the metal trusses, to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Sun Eagle General Contractors Corporation.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$85,079 for the construction contract and \$42,000 for estimated in-house inspection and project management fees, for a total of \$127,079.
