

RESOLUTION NO. 15-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX BY BROWARD COUNTY TO BE USED FOR MARKETING OF THE GREATER FORT LAUDERDALE AREA, BEACH RENOURISHMENT, AND CONVENTION CENTER EXPANSION.

WHEREAS, Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes (2015) provides for imposition of tourist development taxes by the County for specific purposes; and

WHEREAS, Broward County currently has a five percent (Five cents on each dollar) tourist development tax; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale would support an additional one percent tourist development tax if such revenue were used by Broward County for the following priorities: marketing of the greater Fort Lauderdale area; beach renourishment; and convention center expansion; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports an additional one cent/1% tourist development tax by Broward County if it is used to the extent permitted by law for the following priorities: marketing of the greater Fort Lauderdale area; beach renourishment; and convention center expansion.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final adoption.
