TITLE: **REVISED CM-8** Motion Designating the Land Development Manager as
City Engineer on an Interim Basis

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion designating the current Land Development Manager Alex Scheffer, a registered civil engineer licensed in the State of Florida from the Department of Sustainable Development as the City Engineer on an interim basis, effective retroactively to October 23, 2015.

Background

The City Code requires the City Engineer to administer Chapter 25 of the Code of Ordinances, which includes administering Right of Ways and other portions of the Code of Ordinances. Section 2-122 of the City Code of Ordinances provides: "The city engineer shall be the head of the engineering division of the public works department and shall be a registered civil engineer."

The Public Works Director, as a registered Civil Engineer, served in the capacity of City Engineer (as required under Section 2-122 of the City Code) until October 23, 2015.

Resource Impact

The fiscal impact of this action will be \$4,969.12 annually and will be pro-rated based on the length of the interim assignment.
