TITLE: Motion Authorizing the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Restroom Building
Re-Roofing Project - Advanced Roofing, Inc. - \$63,874 Task Order

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a task order (exhibit 1) for the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Restroom Building Project to Advanced Roofing Inc., our continuing annual roofing contractor, in the amount of \$63,874.

Background

The existing standing seam metal roof at the restroom building is severely or completely corroded in majority of areas. During the facility assessment, this building was identified as needing improvements and renovations, including providing a new roof. After careful study and consideration, it has been determined that the new roof should be provided from a material that will better withstand the harsh weather conditions of the beach. Staff recommends proceeding with an aluminum standing seam roof for the building.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$63,874 for the task order, and \$10,858 for estimated in-house project management fees, for a total amount of \$74,732.
