TITLE:	Motion to Approve Master Service Agreement for Purchase of TeamMate Cloud-Based Audit Software – Wolters Kluwer Financial Services, Inc \$10,155

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the TeamMate Global License, Support and Services Agreement and the purchase of cloud-based online audit software from Wolters Kluwer Financial Services, Inc. for a total annual cost of \$10,155.

Background

The City Auditor's Office has been using proprietary TeamMate software on a selfhosted server located in the City's computer room. This same software is now available from the vendor as a hosted cloud-based solution. The Information Technology Services department endorses the transition to the cloud-based service.

Pursuant to Section 2-189, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the City may purchase proprietary items, as defined in Section 2-173, without the necessity of public bids. As defined by the Code, a proprietary item is not readily available from more than one supplier, manufacturer, or person and is unique in nature. A self-hosted version of TeamMate was purchased as a proprietary item in the past, therefore the cloud-based version should also be considered proprietary.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$10,155.
