TITLE: Motion to Approve Cancellation of Contract Negotiations and Reject all

Responses Received for Payment Kiosk Services - Global Express

Money Orders, Inc. and EZ Card Services

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the cancellation of contract negotiations for payment kiosk services with Global Money Orders, Inc. (Global). It is also recommended that the City Commission approve the rejection of responses received from Global and EZ Card Services in response to Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 755-11580.

## **Background**

On October 6, 2015 (CAM 15-1100), the City Commission approved the final ranking of RFQ 755-11580 and authorized the commencement of contract negotiations for payment kiosk services with Global.

Staff has been unable to finalize contract negotiations with the vendor due to the vendor's inability to incorporate the City's project into their current 2016 development schedule, as well as their inability to produce a cost for the project.

Pursuant to Section 2-180(5), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, staff recommends the City cease negotiations, reject the responses received, re-evaluate the marketplace for a more compatible solution and find that the public interest will be served thereby.
