TITLE:	Motion to Approve the Purchase of Fixed License Plate Readers – Safeware, Inc. and CDW-G - \$84,324.84

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase and installation of fixed license plate readers (LPR) *via* the U.S. Communities contract #4400001839 from Safeware, Inc. in the amount of \$54,105.65, and the purchase of related mounting hardware *via* the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance (IPA) Technology Solutions contract # 130733 from CDW-G in the amount of \$30,219.19.

Background

On May 5, 2015, the City Commission accepted a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security through the Miami Urban Area Security Initiative. A portion of this funding was allocated to acquire fixed LPR's. This grant-approved project supports intelligence and information sharing by allowing for the routine gathering of license plate data which can prevent, preempt and deter acts of terrorism and other criminal activities. The license plate readers will allow for situational awareness and law enforcement responses to captured information in real time. The retrieved data can also be utilized for identifying witnesses, developing watch-lists, placing witnesses or suspects at scenes, and more. The LPR system also allows for captured information to be shared between agencies within the region to assist in crime reduction efforts since criminals often cross jurisdictional boundaries.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(7) Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the purchases will be made in accordance with U.S. Communities Contract No. 4400001839 from Safeware, Inc. for \$54,105.65 and in accordance with National IPA Contract No. 130733 from CDW-G for \$30,219.19, whereby such contracts or formal bid followed formal bid procedures of sealed written bids, public opening, and legal advertising.

Resource Impact

The total project cost for the license plate readers project will be \$84,324.84. Funds were appropriated through CAM #15-0487.
