TITLE: Resolution to Approve the Consolidated Budget Amendment to Fiscal
Year 2016 - Appropriation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

Background

Budget amendments are consolidated into one agenda item for consideration at the first meeting of each month.

Examples of recommended actions within the consolidated budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- amendment to staffing level;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Operating Budget and Community Investment Plan by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

Parks & Recreation

A. Appropriation of Grant Funds and Match – Beach Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) & Grant Funds - Las Olas Marina and Access Dredging Phase I Grant - \$466,689

The Parks and Recreation Department was awarded a Florida Inland Navigation District Grant in the amount of \$258,898 for the completion of the Design and Permitting of the Las Olas Marina and Access Dredging Phase I. There is a match requirement in the amount of \$207,791 from the Beach CRA Fund. This budget amendment is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-0095.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget in the Grant Fund and Beach CRA Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$466,689 (\$258,898 grant; \$207,791 Beach CRA Fund match) for the award of the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Grant and Match for the Las Olas Marina and Access Dredging Phase I Project.

B. Appropriation of Grant Funds and Match - Beach Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) & Grant Funds - Bahia Mar Yachting Center Dredging Project Phase I Grant - \$297,004

The Parks and Recreation Department was awarded a Florida Inland Navigation District Grant in the amount of \$206,543 for the Bahia Mar Yachting Center Dredging Project Phase I. There is a match requirement in the amount of \$90,461 from Beach CRA Fund. This budget amendment is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-0096.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget in the Grant Fund and Beach CRA Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$297,004 (\$206,543 grant; \$90,461 Beach CRA Fund match) for the award of the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Grant and Match for the Las Olas Marina and Access Dredging Phase I Project.

C. Appropriation of Grant Funds and Match - Beach Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) & Grant Funds - Memorial Day Weekend Beach Activities Grant - \$39,200

The Parks and Recreation Department was awarded a grant from the Broward County Cultural Tourism Division in the amount of \$19,600 to support the marketing and advertising of the City's Memorial Day weekend activities. There is a match requirement in the amount of \$19,600 from the Beach CRA Fund. This budget amendment is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-0087. The CRA match funds were approved by the CRA Board for beach marketing activities as part of the adoption of the FY 2016 operating budget.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget in the Grant Fund and Beach CRA Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$39,200 (\$19,600 grant; \$19,600 Beach CRA Fund match) for the award of the Broward County Cultural Tourism Division Grant and Match for the Memorial Day weekend beach activities.

Police

D. Appropriation from Fund Balance – Justice Task Force Fund – Primary Weapons Systems Upgrade - \$118,500

The Fort Lauderdale Police Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team is responsible for conducting life-saving missions that are beyond the scope of patrol. The team receives specialized training and uses advanced equipment in order to save lives. The team needs to upgrade its (35) thirty-five primary weapon systems, which have been used since 2001. The new rifles will provide the greater reliability and accuracy needed to conduct these rescue missions. Federal Equitable Sharing allows Departments to make these purchases using funds from the Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture Program, also known as the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund. The total price for the (35) rifles is \$45,253.25 through Bravo Company, which is a sole source provider of the weapon systems.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department (FLPD) also budgets funds annually to replenish its supply of ammunition at a cost of \$73,000 in FY 2016. This ammunition is required to be periodically exchanged to assure it is functional and free of contamination. This budget amendment is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-0086.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget in the Justice Task Force Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$45,500 for the upgrade of thirty-five primary weapons, and \$73,000 to replenish the supply of ammunition.

Transportation & Mobility

E. Appropriation from Reserves - Airport Fund - Community Investment Plan (CIP) - Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Design Pavement Rehabilitation of Taxiway Foxtrot at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport – \$17,500

The Transportation and Mobility Department was awarded a grant of up to \$17,500 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the pavement design of Taxiway Foxtrot at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport. Funding for this project is for the re-design of the taxiway intersections to conform to Federal Aviation Administration's

(FAA) design standards to improve airfield operations. The grant was appropriated on January 5, 2016.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan and the Airport Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$17,500 for internal engineering fees which are ineligible for grant reimbursement.

F. Appropriation of Grant – Airport Fund – Community Investment Plan (CIP) – Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Design Airfield Electrical Vault Improvements - \$64,000

The Transportation and Mobility Department was awarded a grant of up to \$64,000 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the design of the electrical/emergency generator vault at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport. The last major upgrade to the electrical/generator vault was completed in 2001. Since then, there have been upgrades in regulator/transformer equipment that can reduce the operating and maintenance costs for the Airport and increase energy efficiency by replacing the existing equipment.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan and the Airport Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$64,000 for the FDOT grant.

Sustainable Development

G. Transfer between Capital Projects- Northwest Progresso Heights Funds- NFP CRA Street Improvement Grant - \$329,503

Since the inception of the Streetscape Grant Programs, the program has been used as a tool to leverage private investment into the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights (NPH) Community Redevelopment Agency. This budget amendment will provide funding for streetscape improvements at the Fairfield at Flagler Village, which is a six story, 292 unit luxury rental apartment housing development. It includes 16 efficiency units, 191 one bed units, and 85 three bedroom units with a 410 unit parking garage. This budget amendment is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-0066.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts to fund the transfer request for \$329,503 from the Business Incentives project to the NFP CRA Street Improvement Grant project. This represents 50% of the total cost of streetscape improvements of \$659,006. The remaining 50% will be covered by the developer.

Public Works

H. Appropriation for Modified Revenue and Related Expenditures - General Capital Projects Fund- Las Olas Isles Area “B” – Undergrounding of Utility Facilities – \$148,731

The City Commission approved the underground utility line assessment program at the August 20, 2013 Regular Meeting (CAM 13-1029). The program provides that the City will incur upfront costs for preparation and construction of plans for utility underground services. Property owners of the affected area will reimburse the City through an assessment fee to be collected through the City’s utility billing system. The estimated cost for the utility design is \$148,731, which will be reimbursed over a period of two years.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$148,731 to fund the Las Olas Isles Undergrounding of Utilities Project.

City Manager

I. Appropriation of Match Funds from Harbordale Civic Association, Inc. - General Capital Projects Fund - 2014 Neighborhood Community Investment Program (NCIP) Landscape Median Project– \$2,000

The City Commission awarded a 2014 NCIP matching grant in the amount of \$8,000 to the Harbordale Civic Association, Inc. for improvements to the median on Southeast 10 Avenue between Southeast 12th Street and Southeast 14th Court in Harbordale. The Harbordale Civic Association has now provided a match of 6,000 Citizens Volunteers Corps (CVC) points and \$2,000 for the project.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Community Investment Plan by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$2,000 for the neighborhood match towards the NCIP Harbordale Landscape Median Project.

City Attorney

J. Appropriation of General Fund - Fund Balance to fund additional external legal counsel fees associated with the Bahia Mar lease – \$100,000

The City Commission approved \$100,000 in external legal fees associated with negotiation, drafting and review of the Bahia Mar lease. The City Attorney’s Office anticipates that due to the complexity of ongoing work related to this lease, an additional \$100,000 will be required to pay for these services.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget in the General Fund by amending the appropriate accounts in the amount of \$100,000.
